- Ensure the safety, health, and wellbeing of each camper in your group.
- Engage and participate in all camp activities alongside your campers.
- Lead and support cabin and camp-wide activities, including mealtimes, rest periods, and special events.
- Embrace challenges and step beyond your comfort zone, fostering an environment of growth and learning.
- Conduct and participate in activity sessions, utilizing your skills to enrich the camper experience.
- Prepare and maintain reports, evaluations, and communications as required.
- Attend all training sessions and staff meetings, contributing to the collective success of our team.
- Promote and uphold the camp's values, ensuring a respectful and inclusive environment for all.
- Actively maintain and contribute to the camp's spirit and community ethos.

- Participation in a mandatory pre-camp Training Session is required.
